

Suddenly my father was behaving slightly abnormal and required help to do his daily routine. we observed and decided to consult a doctor in Banaras Hindu University, Banaras. The treating doctors advised CT scan Brain for him. CT Brain report turned out to be a cancerous Brain tumor. For confirmation, they advised MRI.

We moved to Mumbai for further treatment, where we consulted with our known family doctor, who suggest to consult with neurosurgeon as Surgery was required.

He suggested to go to Dr Shashank Joshi (Consultant Neurosurgeon) practicing at Seven hills hospital for surgery. Dr. Shashank joshi and Dr Shradha Maheshwari operated upon him. They removed tumor completely which is extremely important. After surgery, the tumor was sent for histopathology examination (biopsy). Report turned out to be a Glioblastoma Multiforme Grade 4. After surgery my father started living normal life. He can walk, can do his routine his own. He is doing his work like bringing vegetable from market etc. everything is going fine.

Dr. Joshi suggested for Further treatment in TMH. We met with Dr. Tejpal Gupta in TMH, who said GBM is dangerous tumor which is not curable and average life is 1-2 years. They suggested to take 33days radiation with 120mg Temozolomide (TMZ). After one month rest, he was switched over to 320mg TMZ for six months cycle.

After this regular follow up in the form of MRI was made. Report is very good and doctors saying its miracle. Now my father is living normal life.

I assumed surgery has worked this miracle which is done by Dr. Shashank Joshi and Dr Shradha Maheshwari. He is very good surgeon. He is like god for my father. I am very thankful to him. Thank you so much Sir.
